Welcome and Introductions

Joy Hinkle of the Metro Water District staff welcomed the Council and initiated introductions. Council members introduced themselves and shared their particular personal or professional interest in the basin.

Preliminary Draft Watershed Management Plan

Steve Haubner of the Metro Water District staff gave an overview of the preliminary draft of the Watershed Management Plan. He explained the purpose of the meeting was to be an informal question and answer session about the preliminary draft plan and encouraged Council members to speak up about topics and sections where more information was needed. Council members provided the following questions and comments:

- Include strategies for TMDLs in the Basin Profiles, particularly for bacteria standards
- Who is monitoring post-development actions? "Past Sins" have to be captured during redevelopment. Need to consider community goals for individual properties.
- 5.C.3 generally OK for contractors – state law really covers a lot of folks in regard to E&S.
- Need to consider legal responsibilities for Extent Level Service policies.
- Need to ensure quality of monitoring samples.
- There are unique source water watersheds in the Flint basin – need to give consideration of buffers, setbacks, etc.

Next Meetings

Matt Harper of the Metro Water District staff explained the expected timeline for the remainder of the plan update process. He announced there would be a joint meeting of all six Basin Advisory Councils on Tuesday, July 29, 2008 to review the preliminary drafts of the Long-term Wastewater Management Plan and the Water Supply and Water Conservation Management Plan. He encouraged Council members to look for email reminders and to check the website for meeting and plan update information.
