Matt Harper of the Metro Water District staff opened the meeting, initiated introductions and reviewed the meeting agenda with the group.

### **Public Comment Period**

There were no public comments.

### **Update on State Water Plan Resource Assessments**

Wei Zeng of Georgia EPD, led a discussion concerning the State's efforts to establish river basin models for conducting resource assessments. The discussion included an overview of the current river basin maps and planning nodules, new State database of withdrawals and discharges, a discussion of the watershed planning tool, USGS efforts to help fill gaps in data, and an overview of how the various upstream/downstream planning councils will work together. Committee members asked for examples of how Georgia EPD would manage conflict resolution between councils and also asked Mr. Zeng to walk through an example resource assessment. The discussion concluded with an overview of the resource assessment timeline and a request for TCC members to review their jurisdiction's data on the river basin maps.

### **Wastewater and Watershed Metrics Discussion**

Corey Babb and Steve Haubner of the Metro Water District Staff led a discussion concerning the development of metrics for the Wastewater and Watershed Management Plans. Committee members expressed their opinions on various options presented and suggested alternative approaches.
